Graduation at John Jay College of Criminal Justice is a great celebration of the successes our students have achieved. Yet each year, the College sees increasingly more students realizing this life-long dream when they walk across the stage at Madison Square Garden.

The 2009-2010 year saw 2,622 John Jay students earn degrees!

In 2009-2010, John Jay College of Criminal Justice awarded 16 Certificates; 258 Associate degrees; 1,769 Bachelor degrees, and 579 Master's degrees. 67% of degrees awarded are Bachelor degrees, and 22% are Master's degrees.
