We are pleased to announce that several scholarships will be available to selected John Jay undergraduate, Master's and BA/MA students who wish to participate in the College's Ninth Biennial International Conference to be held from June 2<sup>nd</sup> to June 5<sup>th</sup> in Marrakesh, Morocco. The theme of the conference is *Societies in Transition: Balancing Security, Social Justice and Tradition*.

If selected by the Scholarship Committee, students can receive a maximum of \$1,000 to attend the conference (total estimated cost, with airfare, is \$1,600 in a shared room at the conference hotel).

The goal of student participation is to expose students to various aspects of international scholarship, networking with Moroccan peers, and professional conferencing experiences. Accordingly, scholarship recipients will be expected to present a poster on a research topic consistent with proposed themes, work with conference staff, and attend a significant number of presentations. Interested junior and senior undergraduates and graduate students who have AT LEAST a 3.0 GPA must submit a hardcopy of the following packet: The John Jay Scholarship General Application is available online at <http://www.jjay.cuny.edu/GeneralScholarshipApplication09.pdf>. The application also requires:

- A biographical statement (mandatory)
- Two letters of recommendation (mandatory)
- A short abstract of the presentation, 1 – 2 pages (mandatory)
- A copy of faculty approved paper or working paper of the research project (if available)
- One letter of nomination (must be from a John Jay faculty member to indicate she/he is supervising your research) (mandatory--can be the same person who writes a recommendation)
