BUILDING OPERATION, MAINTENANCE, AND RECORDKEEPING

PLEASE NOTE: THIS COURSE PERTAINS TO ALL CURRENT FIRE SAFETY DIRECTORS AND C OF F HOLDERS.

This course was created to comply with the New York City Fire Departments Fire Code Section 113.7.3 which states "Certificate renewals shall be at the discretion of the Commissioner in the interest of public safety based on a review of the certificate holder's qualifications and fitness. The department may review certificate holder's qualifications and fitness and may require a certificate holder to complete a department approved continuing education program and/or provide other proof of the holders continuing qualifications and fitness." This course has been approved by the Fire Departments, and will explain, and examine the changes to the various codes, rules and procedures that directly affect the Fire Safety Director. New terminology will be introduced, as well as reviewing other areas that the Fire Department deems necessary.

Any FSD certificate of fitness that is required to be renewed between October 1, 2010 and September 30, 2014 will require the C of F holder to attend an approved class and pass an exam given in that class in order to renew their C of F.

After the applicant passes the class exam they will be given a Letter of Completion from the school, which they will bring to FDNY Headquarters, pay the required renewal fee and will receive a new C of F which will be good for three years. Candidate needs only to take this course once to comply.
