THE FIRE SCIENCE INSTITUTE

Fire departments across the country are preparing for new, high risk situations while striving to maintain basic preparedness. The Fire Science Institute helps professionals in the firefighting field meet new challenges while continuing to prepare the next generation of personnel. The Institute hosts educational programs for professionals, educators and researchers. Basic training programs have included test preparation for the written and physical exam for the Fire Department, City of New York (FDNY); the FDNY's cadet training program; and a program integrating college students into the fire service.

Specialized programs are developed for public and private agencies and include the Fire Safety Directors Program for high rise buildings, hotels, and hospitals; arson related Juvenile Firesetters program for the FDNY Fire Marshals; Train the Trainer Programs for the health and safety instructors of the New York State Professional Firefighters Association and the Uniformed Fire Officers Association of New York City; and Building Operation, Maintenance, and Recordkeeping (Recertification Course).

CONSOLIDATED FIRE SAFETY DIRECTORS COURSE

This 5-week course is designed to prepare candidates for the Certificate of Fitness (CoF) as a Fire Safety Director (F-58/Z50) as administered by the Bureau of Fire Prevention, Fire Department, City of New York. **The FSD Recertification course for Building Operation, Maintenance and Recordkeeping is now included in our Consolidated Fire Safety Directors Program.** Passing the Course enables candidates with applicable experience to apply to the FDNY to take the Fire Safety Directors Examination. With a passing exam grade and verification of applicable experience, the candidate will be eligible for the onsite examination. After passing the onsite exam, a CoF will be issued by the FDNY.

Applicable experience for candidates: Must be at least 18 years of age and have at least three years of related fire experience, building management, or a satisfactory equivalent of both. The FDNY will evaluate your qualifications. To see if you qualify prior to class, call the FDNY to schedule an appointment at 718.999.2473. A Certificate of Completion will be issued to those who pass the course. Note that completion of the course and issuance of a certificate of completion does not imply that the minimum qualifications for the CoF have been met.
