Where can I get my Immunization Record

1. Your Parents.

- Parents usually have a childhood record or card.

2. Your High School/College

- Call or visit the nurse's office or the immunization office at your high school or prior college.

3. Your Doctor/Clinic

- They may have records or blood test showing immunity to measles, mumps, and rubella.

4. Your Local Health Department.

- May have old records or you can get a new free shot from the Department of Health.
