

Tuition & Fees, and *Estimated* Cost of Living Expenses for International Students attending John Jay College of Criminal Justice – CUNY

Studying in the United States requires a guarantee of sufficient financial resources to meet the cost of attendance. The United States Consulate abroad requires documentation of financial support before approving the issuance of an F-1 student visa.

International students who are admitted into the United States in F-1 legal status pay the same tuition rate as all other students who pay out of state tuition. Admitted students are responsible for the payment of all tuition and fees at the time of registration for each semester. John Jay College does not provide financial assistance to international students; they must be in a position to finance tuition, fees, room and board, books and incidental expenses.

Tuition and fees for international students attending John Jay College can vary depending on the area and/or level of study. The following cost estimates are based on the minimum full-time enrollment for F-1 students (12 academic credits for undergraduate students and 9 academic credits for graduate students each semester) for 1 academic year (fall and spring semesters). If you register for more courses, your tuition will be higher. A minimum of 120 credits is required to earn a Bachelor's degree. Masters degrees range from 36 to 60 academic credits. Advanced Certificate programs range from 12 to 18 credits.

** Tuition and Fees stated are based on Bachelor's degree students registered for 12 credits per semester. This is the minimum number of credits required to be a full-time undergraduate student (necessary to maintain lawful immigration status). If you take more than 12 credits, you will be charged at the rate of \$560 per credit. Additional fees may apply.

*** Tuition and Fees stated are based on Master's degree/Advanced Certificate students registered for 9 credits per semester. This is the minimum number of credits required to be a full-time graduate student (necessary to maintain lawful immigration status). If you take more than 9 credits, you will be charged at the rate of \$780 per credit. Additional fees may apply.

**** Tuition and Fees stated are based on Master's in Public Administration (MPA) degree students registered for 9 credits per semester. This is the minimum number of credits required to be a full-time graduate student (necessary to maintain lawful immigration status). If you take more than 9 credits, you will be charged at the rate of \$920 per credit. Additional fees may apply.
