
1. External Funding Profile

FIGURE 2. FY 2018 EXTERNAL AWARDS (GRANTS & CONTRACTS) BY CUNY COLLEGE





FIGURE 3. GRANT AND CONTRACT AWARDS TO JOHN JAY COLLEGE PIs, 5-YEAR TREND 2013-2018




2. Scholarly Productivity

OAR continues to steadily increase the reinvestment of indirect recoveries from external grants in a range of targeted internal funding programs.


