## Additional Notes

1. Two of your six major electives may come from outside your selected track.
2. If you become a history major after earning 60 credits, take a seventh elective instead of 150.
3. One History Department general education course (Category D) can count as a major elective.
4. No more than two of your major courses can count towards another major, minor, or certificate.
5. If you wish to apply to graduate programs in social studies education, you will also need two US history courses, one economics course, and one political science course.

## Part Four - Chronological Track Course Options

Students will complete six elective courses (18 credits). History majors who are in the Honors track will complete five elective courses (15 credits). Two of the elective courses for all students must be at the 300–level or above. Students will choose one of three chronological tracks: Prehistory to 500 CE; 500–1650; or 1650 to the Present. At least four elective courses (12 credits) must be taken from the declared chronological track. A maximum of one course from Category D (General Electives) may be applied to the elective requirement.
