

First Semester Freshmen Tips for Course Changes

What should my schedule look like?


1. **ENG 101**
2. **Math course** – each student’s Math course will vary depending on a student’s Math Placement Test scores and major
3. **First Year Seminar** – all freshmen are required to complete a First Year Seminar during their first semester at John Jay. If you are a Forensic Science major who has been placed into both CHE 103 and BIO 103, you will take your First Year Seminar during your second semester.
4. **General education course** - consult the First Semester Course options sheet.
5. **Introduction to major** course or **general education** course.

Completing 15 credits each semester will keep you on track to graduate in four years!

- ❖ Always use the **swap feature** from the drop-down menu in your Student Center when making changes to your schedule.
- ❖ Remember all first semester freshmen must have a minimum **three day schedule** and a maximum of **three courses per day!**



Important Notes about Linked Courses and the Interdisciplinary Studies Program (ISP)
