1. WHAT IS A WIRE TRANSFER?

Wire Transfers refer to an electronic transfer of funds one person or entity to another.

2. WHERE ARE WIRE TRANSFERS ACCEPTED?

John Jay accepts the electronic transfer of funds to the College's Tuition & Fees account. Inquire with a Bursar representative for the information you will need to provide to your bank to complete the wire.

3. HOW IS A WIRE TRANSFER RECORDED?

Wire Transfers are posted to the student record as a "Payment by Wire".

4. I HAVE BURSAR HOLDS FOR MY—CAN I USE A WIRE TRANSFER TO REMOVE IT?

Wire Transfers will delay the removal of an account hold until the funds are

- 1. Deposited to John Jay's tuition/fees account and
- 2. Successfully applied to the CUNYfirst system.
