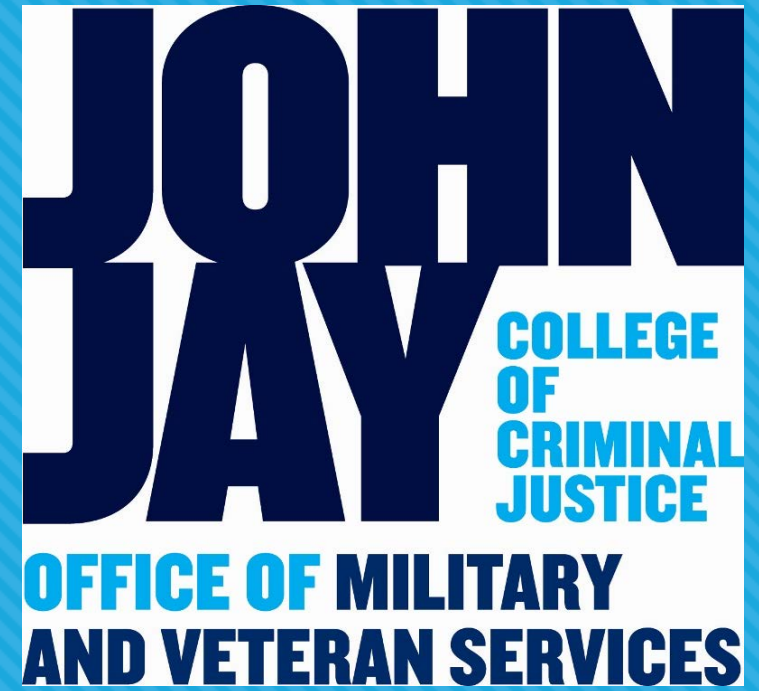

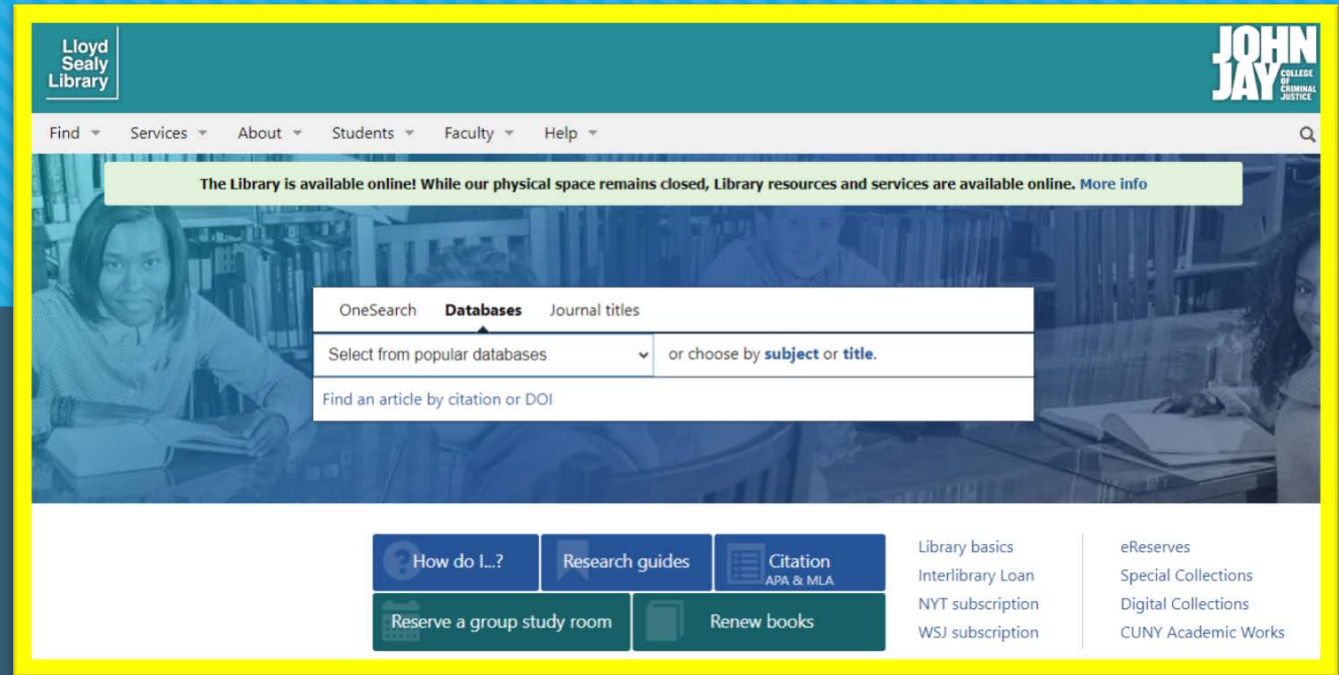

# To Navigate the Online Databases...

- ❑ Step 1: Go to <https://www.jjay.cuny.edu/>
- ❑ Step 2: Click on "Library"
- ❑ Step 3: In the search bar, click "Databases"
- ❑ Step 4: Select a database that works best for you, depending on the course and the subject material in which you are interested.

For example: If you are looking for specifically psychological research, look at "PsychInfo". Another popular database is "GoogleScholar" and "Academic Search Complete".

- ❑ Step 5: Log in using your John Jay College Email credentials
- ❑ Step 6: Begin searching for academic research and information by searching keywords related to the subject area of which you are interested
