A.nnotate lets you share and store notes on documents. When you upload a document A.nnotate displays it in the browser and lets you add notes and tags to specific words, phrases and regions of the page. You can share documents so that other people can add notes and replies. All notes are added to your personal document index.	FlipGrid is a social learning tool, where students can engage video discussions for reflection, making predictions about upcoming activities or learning experiences, and sharing insights with one another. Instructors create a topic, and students post responses on their own time. This is a useful tool for previewing content or preparing for first year events, like group advising or the first year showcase.	Voicethread is a tool that permits you to upload documents, audios files, videos, or presentations and engage groups in commenting using text, audio or video features. It can be used for students to comment on readings, to introduce themselves to one another, or to reflect on discussions begun in class.	Coggle is a collaborative concept map creator that permits collaboration between anyone who has the link to a chart. Instructors can generate charts to be share with students or students can generate questions, brainstorm, or present components of a complex process or idea.	Time.graphics is a planning and organizing tool that learners can use to draft detailed or simple timelines to explain a process, map their goals, or document historical events. Students developing a set of goals for college and careers could create a timeline of activities and events they plan to participate in in the future.	Digication is an ePortfolio tool that students can use to create their own personal web pages to document learning, planning, or professional experiences. Students can work within an instructor designed template or create their own to document their learning and exploration in a course, or they can create a professional ePortfolio that they add to and expand upon as they participate in various experiences during their college careers.	Prezi is an online presentation development tool that students can use to illustrate a key idea or present research. The free version of prezi gives users the opportunity to adapt existing templates or create their own. Users can also add sound and publish their prezis to share with others.	Canva is a free tool with some paywalls that students can use to create infographics, charts, or other visual representations of their learning. Canva can be used to create infographics to show a decision making process or present data. Using a tool like Canva is also a great way to practice presentation and communication skills in a different format than PowerPoint.	My Next Move is career exploration and planning website that students can access on their own, or with guidance from an instructor. Options available to students include a skills and interest quiz, a set of profiles of different occupations, and connections to training information. The site is free to anyone who wants to use it. Students can use My Next Move to make connections between their interests and possible career paths, and to check out the education requirements they may need to complete to access work that interests them.	The career earnings by major tool is a free planning tool that shows students the economic benefits of different majors. Students can use this as a component of their major selection process.	ConnectEd studios day in the life videos are a series of resources students can access to learn more about careers that may interest them. Students can access these videos to learn more about the realities of the careers that interest them.
