1. Visit https://app.applyyourself.com/AYApplicantLogin/fl_ApplicantConnectLogin.asp?id=cunyjjaygr to apply for admission.
2. A non-refundable application fee of \$125.00 in the form of check or money order payable to "John Jay College" (do not send cash). Veterans/Active Military must submit copies of their DD-214 or military documentation in-person or to graduateadmissions@jjay.cuny.edu to be waived from the application fee.
3. Official Undergraduate/Graduate transcripts from ALL schools attended.
4. Personal statement and letters of recommendation if you did not utilize the online options within the application.
5. Appropriate standardized test scores if required by your program (GRE, TOEFL, LSAT).
6. The MA in Forensic Psychology, MA in Forensic Mental Health Counseling, MA/JD in Forensic Psychology and Law, MA in Forensic Science, MS in Digital Forensics and Cybersecurity, Computer Science for Digital Forensics and Applied Digital Forensic Certificate programs all require GRE exams.

Standards for Admissions:

- 3.0 minimum undergraduate cumulative GPA
- GRE score varies by program
- Pre-requisite coursework varies by program
