

LABRENDA GARRETT-NELSON CHILDREN'S CENTER SCHOLARSHIP

Established through the generous support of Distinguished Alumna and trustee of the John Jay College Foundation, LaBrenda Garrett-Nelson (BA '75), the LaBrenda Garrett-Nelson Children's Center Scholarship provides a one-time scholarship, up to \$1,250, to a matriculated John Jay student who currently has a child enrolled in the Children's Center. The scholarship is awarded each semester (two scholarships per academic year) and is intended to help defray the costs of tuition and child-care.

AWARD AMOUNT:

Up to \$1,250

REQUIREMENTS:

- **Have a child currently enrolled in the Children's Center, with regular attendance**
- Be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student
- Have completed at least one semester at John Jay College
- Have a minimum 2.8 GPA
- Demonstrate financial need, determined through a completed FAFSA

APPLICATION:

- A complete John Jay College General Scholarship Application (online)
- An essay (maximum of 400 words) discussing how the services provided by the Children's Center have assisted you in attaining your educational goals.
