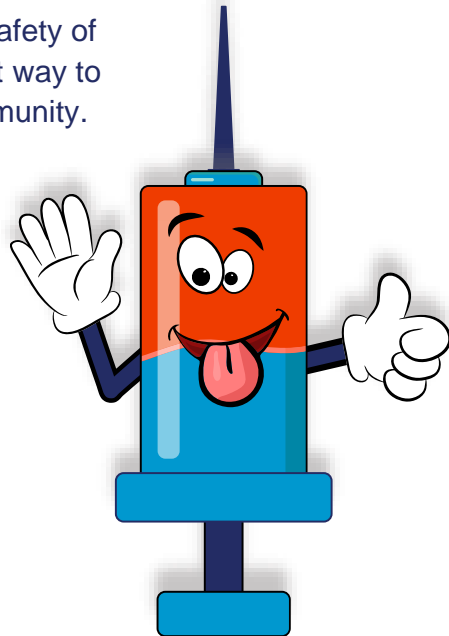

CUNY Vaccination & Testing Guidelines

[The FDA granted full approval](#) to the Pfizer vaccine on August 23, 2021. CUNY students are now required to be fully vaccinated and must have their vaccination documentation uploaded and approved in CUNYfirst within 45 days.

Students now have until September 27 to upload proof of vaccination into CUNYfirst, so the documents can be approved and verified by October 7, the 45-day mark.

Submit Proof of Vaccination

Upload your vaccination information on CUNYfirst (or receive a religious exception or medical exemption) by **September 27, 2021**. Make sure to check back your CUNYfirst vaccination verification page for approval confirmation before coming to campus. If your vaccination status hasn't been approved, you will need to show proof of negative test.

Show Proof of Negative Test

Students who are not fully vaccinated or receive a religious exception/medical exemption will need to show proof of negative test from a CUNY test site. The test is free and must be taken **48 hours and no more than 7 days** before coming to campus.
