It is with great sadness that I am writing to inform you that Campus Peace Officer, Rangel Nuñez, from the Department of Public Safety at John Jay College, City University of New York, passed away on Friday, November 20th as the result of an existing medical condition. He leaves behind a seven-year-old son (Martin) and other heart-broken family members, friends and colleagues.

A viewing will be held for CPO Nuñez on Tuesday, November 24th, at the D'Bari Funeral Home located at 605 E. 188th Street, Bronx, NY 10458. Visitation hours will be from 5:00 pm - 8:00 pm. Due to current health restrictions, only 25 people will be permitted inside at any one time. There will be a waiting area adjacent to the funeral home.

A funeral mass will be held on Wednesday, November 25th at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church, 627 East 187th Street, Bronx, NY 10458. The mass will be limited to 75 attendees inside the church, and will run from 9:45 am - 10:30 am and will be followed immediately by a burial at St. Raymond's Cemetery, 2600 Lafayette Avenue, Bronx, NY 10465. Again, due to COVID restrictions, only 25 people will be permitted inside the gates of the cemetery.
