



## A.A. Criminal Justice → B.A. International Criminal Justice

Borough of Manhattan Community College (BMCC) graduates who complete the Associate of Arts degree in Criminal Justice will receive 60 credits toward the Bachelor of Arts degree in International Criminal Justice at John Jay College of Criminal Justice as indicated below.
