



## A.A. Liberal Arts → B.A. Philosophy

Borough of Manhattan Community College (BMCC) graduates who complete the Associate of Arts degree in Liberal Arts will receive 60 credits toward the Bachelor of Arts degree in Philosophy at John Jay College of Criminal Justice as indicated below.
