

2010 FACULTY GRADUATION GUIDE

This Graduation Guide answers questions and offer helpful hints for your participation in the 2010 Graduation Ceremony.

This year will mark the 45th ceremony for John Jay College of Criminal Justice. Graduation will be held on Thursday, May 27, 2010 at the Theater at Madison Square Garden (Seventh Avenue and 32nd Street).

GETTING THERE

Public transportation is the best way to get to the Theater at Madison Square Garden. The B, D, F, V, N, Q, R and W trains stop at 34th Street and Avenue of the Americas, which is a block away. The 1, 2, 3, A, C and E trains, and the LIRR stop at Penn Station. The entrance to the Theater is on Seventh Avenue and 32nd Street.

ARRIVAL TIME

Two ceremonies are being held and you are welcome to attend both or choose the one where you know the most students. Upon arrival at the Garden, please follow signs to the North concierge area.

For the 10:30 AM – 1:30 PM Ceremony

If you are attending the 10:30 am ceremony, please arrive by 9:30 am

Students in attendance at this ceremony will receive degrees in Computer Information Systems, Criminology, Deviant Behavior, English, Forensic Computing, Forensic Psychology, Forensic Science, International Criminal Justice, Judicial Studies, Justice Studies, Legal Studies, Mental Health Counseling, Political Science (Government) and Dispute Resolution Certificate.

For the 3:30 PM – 6:30 PM Ceremony

If you are attending the 3:30 pm ceremony, please arrive by 2:30 pm

Students in attendance at this ceremony will receive degrees in Correctional Administration, Correctional Studies, Criminal Justice, Criminal Justice Administration and Planning, Economics, Fire Science, Police Studies, Protection Management, Public Administration, and Security Management.

ROBING

You will be able to robe in the North concierge area.

If you have ordered the rental of your academic attire from Josten's, you will be able to pick up your robe at the College a few days prior to the ceremony. If you have not picked up your robe in advance of the ceremony, a Josten's representative will be distributing previously ordered robes in the North Concierge area.

Josten's will also have a limited supply of academic attire available for rental at MSG.

Payment is due at the time of rental.

The prices are as follows:

-Doctoral Unit (Mortar Board Square Cap, Gown and Tassel) and Doctoral Hood – \$40.00

-Master's Unit (Mortar Board Square Cap, Gown, Tassel) and a Master's Hood - \$35.00

When the ceremony concludes, you should return your rented attire by placing it in the Josten's bins located in the North Concierge area.
