

GRADUATION 2009 FACULTY CHECKLIST

This Graduation Checklist answers questions and offer helpful hints for your participation in the 2009 Graduation Ceremony.

This year will mark the 44th ceremony for John Jay College of Criminal Justice. Graduation will be held on Thursday, May 28, 2009 at the Theater at Madison Square Garden (Seventh Avenue and 32nd Street).

✓ GETTING THERE

Public transportation is the best way to get to the Theater at Madison Square Garden. The B, D, F, V, N, Q, R and W trains stop at 34th Street and Avenue of the Americas, which is a block away. The 1, 2, 3, A, C and E trains, and the LIRR stop at Penn Station. The entrance to the Theater is on Seventh Avenue and 32nd Street.

Two ceremonies are being held and you are welcome to attend both or choose the one where you know the most students. Upon arrival at the Garden, please follow signs to the North Concierge area.

10:30 AM Ceremony

If you are attending the 10:30 AM ceremony, please arrive by 9:30 AM.

Students in attendance at this ceremony will receive degrees in Computer Information Systems, Criminology, Deviant Behavior, Government, International Criminal Justice, Judicial Studies, Justice Studies, Forensic Psychology, Forensic Computing, Forensic Mental Health Counseling, Legal Studies and Dispute Resolution Certificate.

3:30 PM Ceremony

If you are attending the 3:30 PM ceremony, please arrive by 2:30 PM.

Students in attendance at this ceremony will receive degrees in Forensic Science, Correctional Administration, Correctional Studies, Criminal Justice, Criminal Justice Administration and Planning, Fire Science, Police Studies, Public Administration, Protection Management, and Security Management.

✓ **ROBING**

You will be able to robe in the North Concierge area.

If you are renting your academic attire from Josten's, you will be able to pick up your robe at the College a few days prior to the ceremony. If you have not picked up your robe in advance of the ceremony, a Josten's representative will be distributing previously ordered robes in the North Concierge area. Please note that if you plan to rent your academic attire the day of the graduation ceremony, your selection will be limited and you may not get your desired hood color.

Robe rental fees can only be paid by check or money order to Josten's. When the ceremony concludes, you can return your rented attire by placing it in the Josten's bins located in the North Concierge area.
