- The Vice President for Enrollment Management & Student Affairs (EMSA) will provide executive leadership, oversight and evaluation for the Enrollment Management and Student Affairs division. In this role, the EMSA Vice President will strategically plan all enrollment, recruitment, and student services activities in coordination with other College departments, and work to promote a student-centered campus community that supports the personal, social, and academic development of all students. The EMSA Vice President will prioritize working directly with students, and will serve as a student advocate and mentor in expansive efforts to promote student leadership and success.
- As described in my message following the Climate Review, the inaugural Vice President for Diversity. Equity, Compliance & Inclusion (DECI) will lead a new Office and bring experienced and collaborative leadership as well as a strategic vision to the College's cross-cutting work to build an inclusive and equitable community. The new Vice President for DECI will oversee and manage compliance and accountability functions, alongside training, education, and prevention programming, providing expert advice and thought leadership in these areas.
