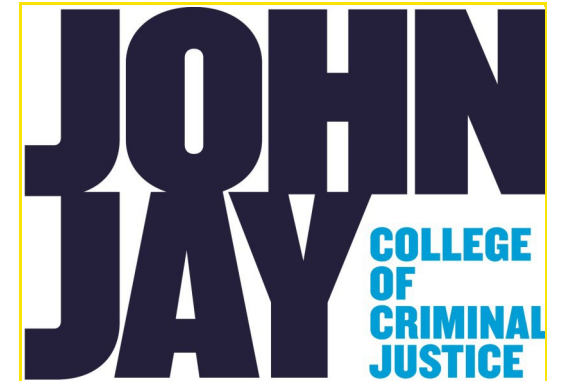
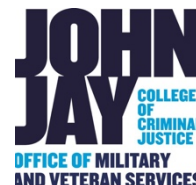

- ☐☐ Veterans/Active Military can be WAIVED from paying the \$125 graduate application fee by submitting copies of their DD-214 or military documentation in-person or to [graduateadmissions@jjay.cuny.edu](mailto:graduateadmissions@jjay.cuny.edu).
- ☐☐ Official Undergraduate/Graduate transcripts from ALL schools attended must be provided in signed/sealed envelopes, mailed directly to Graduate Admissions, or submitted electronically at [graduateadmissions@jjay.cuny.edu](mailto:graduateadmissions@jjay.cuny.edu).
- ☐☐ Personal statement and letters of recommendation (normally submitted with the online application).
- ☐☐ Appropriate standardized test scores if required by your program (GRE, TOEFL, LSAT).
- ☐☐ The MA in Forensic Psychology, MA in Forensic Mental Health Counseling, MA/JD in Forensic Psychology and Law, MA in Forensic Science, MS in Digital Forensics and Cybersecurity, Computer Science for Digital Forensics and Applied Digital Forensic Certificate programs may require GRE and/or LSAT exams.

## Standards for Admissions:

- 3.0 minimum undergraduate cumulative GPA
- GRE score varies by program
- Pre-requisite coursework varies by program
