

Discussion: In the January 31 meeting, the Dominican Student Association (DSA) budget was short \$112.50. Because there are no more funds available for club budgets, Debonair Steppers will have their Refreshment budget reduced by \$112.50, which will go to the DSA to make up their shortfall. The Student Council will give \$112.50 from their budget to Debonair Steppers.

Discussion: There are not enough surplus funds to approve all requests from Student Affairs departments and student clubs and organizations. Some student clubs and organizations did not receive a budget for Spring 2017 and the Committee members think those requests should be prioritized over other requests. Other suggestions considered but not voted on are to prioritize requests that were received on time over requests that were submitted late; to de-prioritize requests to fund events; to de-prioritize requests that will not benefit a large portion of the student body; and to approve all requests but reduce the amounts across the board. There are concerns about setting criteria for prioritization of requests after requests have already been solicited, rather than reviewing all surplus proposals equally and allocating funds based on the proposals' merits.

Discussion: The College Print Shop can print the Quill journal for less than the outside printer selected by the INK Club. The INK Club did not solicit a bid from the College Print Shop this year, but in the past the Print Shop did not offer the lowest bid in the bidding process. It is not known if the Print Shop can produce the same quality as the outside printer, which has printed the Quill since its first publication.

There are also concerns about the level of vetting the INK Club's request is receiving compared to the previous request from the Black Student Union.

The subcommittee will create criteria for how clubs, organizations, and departments will request surplus funds in the future, and create criteria for how the Board will decide to allocate surplus funds in the future. The subcommittee will consist of 1 administrator, Michael Martinez-Sachs; 2 students, Jahvar Duffus and Izabela Qafa; and 1 faculty

member, Toy-Fung Tung. Izabela Qafa will chair the subcommittee, which will meet with all due haste and make recommendations to the Board at the next meeting.
