The Italian Diaspora Studies Summer Seminar™ (IDSSS) is delighted to offer free enrollment in the 10th edition of the IDSSS for this coming summer, June 15-July 3, 2026, for up to four members of the teaching faculty and HEO series.

As it has in past editions, the Office of the Executive Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and Provost at the University has offered four fellowships. This enables four CUNY colleagues to attend the three-week professional development seminar on the Italian diaspora at no cost. These participants will stay at a four-star hotel for three weeks, attend classes at Roma Tre University, and receive breakfast and lunch. This fellowship covers the seminar's \$3,500 fee. Airfare and other fees not included.



The Italian Diaspora Studies Summer Seminar is a three-week program held at Roma Tre University. It aims to introduce participants — e.g., doctoral students, professors, and non-academic cultural and community leaders — to the cultural studies of the Italian diaspora from multiple academic perspectives. It also encourages the development of individual projects based on the seminar materials covering literature, film, and social sciences.

The 2025 IDSSS Cohort at Roma Tre University

This is a collaborative program between the John D. Calandra Italian American Institute at Queens College, The City University of New York, and Roma Tre University. Professors from these two institutions, along with others, will comprise the teaching faculty for the entire three weeks. This is the tenth year of the Italian Diaspora Studies Summer Seminar.
