**Students who have completed undergraduate accounting classes can combine the MPA in Inspection and Oversight with the Advanced Certificate in Forensic Accounting to qualify to sit for the CPA examination, and prepare for a second career as a forensic accountant. This is dependent on a full evaluation of prior credits that will determine eligibility.

Dual Degree MPA/JD Program in Law and Public Accountability

The MPA/JD Dual Degree Program capitalizes on CUNY Law School's nationally renowned expertise in Public Service and Public Interest Law with John Jay College's unique and highly recognized MPA program dealing with investigation of waste fraud and abuse in public and publicly regulated services. The dual program will prepare lawyers who will be uniquely trained to for inspection and oversight functions, as practitioners, policy makers and legal scholars.

The curriculum is composed of the existing required and elective courses for the MPA and for the JD. Twelve CUNY Law School credits are credited towards both the JD and the MPA Program. Likewise, 12 MPA credits from the JJCCJ MPA in Inspection and Oversight program are credited also to the CUNY Law School JD program. Consequently, due to the 24 transfer credits applied in the dual degree program, the total number of credits taken will be 106 rather than 130, resulting in graduation for full-time students in four years instead of five. Students must be admitted to both the MPA and the JD programs, so early advising and program applications are recommended.

Dual Degree MPA/MS Program in Public Policy and Protection Management

The MPA/MS dual-degree program in Public Policy and Protection Management offers qualified students the opportunity to earn a Master of Public Administration in Public Policy and Administration and a Master of Science in Protection Management, both specializing in Emergency Management. This dual-degree program prepares students for careers in organizations that plan, design, manage, evaluate and operate protection and emergency management systems. Graduates will be able to design programs and procedures for a variety of public, private, commercial and residential settings.

The MPA-MS dual-degree program in Public Policy and Protection Management requires a combined total of 81 credits, including 42 credits for the completion of the Public Policy and Administration M.P.A. program and 39 credits for the completion of the Protection Management M.S. program. However, nine M.P.A. credits common to both programs are also credited towards the M.S. program. Likewise, nine Protection Management credits from courses common to both programs are also credited toward the M.P.A. program. Consequently, due to the 18 shared credits applied to the dual-degree program, the actual number of credits taken will be 63, resulting in graduation for full-time students in three years instead of the four years necessary to complete both programs independently.
