*A brief explanation of the CUNY John Jay History Major. The majority of students have to take six electives in their chosen chronological periods, and 2 must be at the 300 level. (Honors students take 5 electives, 2 at the 300 level). We will offer elective credit to incoming students on the following basis—that the electives they took at Queensborough are, in fact, in their chosen chronological track (some students might find a new period of interest after starting our program), and that they go on to complete the rest of their electives at John Jay. The courses listed in the first part of category C above are required for both the General Education Requirements and two thirds of the required introductory surveys for the History major. The courses listed in the second part of Category C are electives offered by Queensborough for which we will offer elective credit if the above conditions are satisfied.

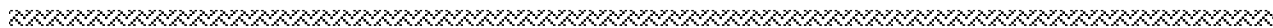
