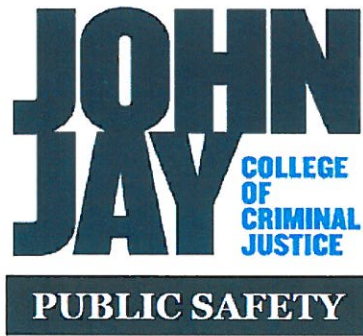


HELP US KEEP YOU SAFE!



- **Don't ignore suspicious activity. Contact the Public Safety Department or report it to a patrol Officer or to the nearest Public Safety Desk.**
- **Avoid secluded and empty areas or rooms. Study in well used areas.**
- **Do not use unoccupied classrooms other than for a scheduled class.**
- **When possible, stay in well-traveled and well lit areas and travel with others.**
- **Always safeguard personal items and valuables such as purses, wallets, laptops, I-Pads, I-Pods, cell phones, etc. and don't leave unattended.**
- **Keep such items with you at all times or securely locked in a drawer or closet.**
- **Always lock your office door even if you are only leaving for a short time.**
- **Never tell anyone that you have large amounts of cash or expensive items in your possession.**
- **Don't leave your keys unsecured or lend them to anyone. Report broken locks to Public Safety immediately.**
- **If you are leaving the College late at night, travel on well-lit streets and stay near the curb away from alleys and entryways. Request a Public Safety escort if you feel threatened.**
- **Contact Public Safety anytime 24 hours a day. Emergency phones are located throughout the campus, including bathrooms.**
